

The market town is also home to a craft fair that occurs once a month selling all kinds of Welsh crafts. Mid August sees the arrival of a Jazz Festival that has proved ever popular with previous guests of the site.

The CAMC Campsites in Wales

Wales is a beautiful country made up mainly of fine upland and stunning coastlines. A fifth of its area is covered by the three national parks, from the mountain wonders of Snowdonia and the Brecon Beacons to the Pembrokeshire Coast.

As well as its scenery, there are some fascinating towns and cities, mainly in the populous south. Cardiff has a castle and a wealth of entertainment options in Cardiff Bay, while Swansea is located by the Gower Peninsula, another area of superb coastline.

The turbulent history of Wales is reflected by its many magnificent castles, while the Welsh language is widely spoken in many rural areas. The most famous manifestation of this comes on the beautiful island of Anglesey, home to Britain's longest place name: the village of; Llanfairpwllgwyngyllgogerychwynodroblantisliliogogoch.

- **What is a Centre Rally/Event?**

A Rally/Event is a relaxed, budget friendly get away and social gathering of Caravan and Motorhome Club members who enjoy weekends with like minded members in the open air, off grid most of the time, but occasionally with the facility of electric hook-up available. It is a chance to explore new places, and are held in unique and varied locations and sometimes near attractions, such as, Airshows, Steam fairs and Christmas markets.

There are 67 Centres across the UK all who provide a programme of Rallies and events throughout the year. The Welsh Division has 4 local Centres, namely, Dyfed, Gwent, South Wales and West Wales. As a Caravan and Motorhome Club member you are able to attend any Rally and/or event the Centres arrange, (subject to availability).

- **What do I need to do to attend a Centre Rally/Event?**

All Centre Rallies/Events are open to all Caravan and Motorhome members. You can visit the Centre Rally listings at the main CAMC website or visit the individual Centre website to view their programme of events. Once you find a rally or event you would like to attend you can book the event, normally online.

provided and as you approach the venue, look out for CAMC Centre signage. When you arrive look out for the Rally Officers. You will be given information about what is planned for the weekend.. You will be shown to your pitch and you will be asked to park your car on the offside of your caravan parallel to the caravan. You will also be shown where the fresh drinking water is and the elsan point. Unless otherwise informed you would be expected to take your general waste home.

- **Social Activities**

The rally/event you have chosen to attend, may have a social included, this is normally a family social and may be a disco, quiz or just background music so you can socialise with others attending. The weekend may include competitions or games for young and old alike. All these are entirely optional but are normally good fun and a good way to meet others on the rally. You can take part in as much or little as you wish.

- **Flag Pole**

This usually takes place on a Sunday morning around 11am and is a chance for everyone on the rally/event to gather together with a cup of tea or coffee and hear the results of the competitions, welcome new ralliers and any visitors. Normally forthcoming events are announced and a chance to thank the rally officers.

- **What do I need to Take?**

To join a Centre Rally/Event you will need your own toilet facilities, the means to collect your own fresh water and a waste water container.

A fully charged 12v battery, as most rallies are off grid. A solar panel is very helpful to keep your battery topped up during the weekend.

If you need any help or assistance whilst on a Centre Rally/Event, there will always be someone on hand who can help or give you advice.


